

In 2012 Kevin Royle visited Ukraine and noticed some very scary equipment deficiencies. Underfunded EMR's were working with worn out equipment and tools. Along with outdated vehicles, crumbling facilities, and inadequate & sometimes missing PPE. These put not only the first responders at risk but the citizens themselves.

Firefighters Aid Ukraine collects any and all unwanted or unneeded PPE, bunker/turnout gear, medical supplies and life rescue equipment. They then take time out of their busy schedules to raise funds in an effort to send these goods to various locations in Ukraine.

# Website has Launched


## MARKETING COMMITTEE
